

Louisiana Mandatory Reporting Requirements Regarding Elders/Disabled	
Who Must Report?	Any person having cause to believe that a case of abuse or neglect of an adult exists
Standard of Knowledge	Cause to believe that an adult's physical or mental health or welfare has been or may be further adversely affected by abuse, neglect, or exploitation
Definition of Applicable Victim	Any person sixty (60) years or older, any disabled person eighteen (18) years of older, or an emancipated minor.
	A disabled person is a person with a mental, physical, or developmental disability that substantially impairs the person's ability to provide adequately for his/her own care or protection.
Reports Made To	Reports shall be made to any adult protection agency or to any local law enforcement agency
Contents of Report	 All reports must contain the following: Name and address of the adult; If known, name and address of the person responsible for the care of the adult; and Any other information that the reporter believes is pertinent.
