

Louisiana Mandatory Reporting Requirements Regarding Elders/Disabled	
<i>Who Must Report?</i>	Any person having cause to believe that a case of abuse or neglect of an adult exists
<i>Standard of Knowledge</i>	Cause to believe that an adult's physical or mental health or welfare has been or may be further adversely affected by abuse, neglect, or exploitation
<i>Definition of Applicable Victim</i>	Any person sixty (60) years or older, any disabled person eighteen (18) years of older, or an emancipated minor. A disabled person is a person with a mental, physical, or developmental disability that substantially impairs the person's ability to provide adequately for his/her own care or protection.
<i>Reports Made To</i>	Reports shall be made to any adult protection agency or to any local law enforcement agency
<i>Contents of Report</i>	All reports must contain the following: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Name and address of the adult; • If known, name and address of the person responsible for the care of the adult; and • Any other information that the reporter believes is pertinent.
